RACE ENTRY AGREEMENT

In consideration of acceptance of my entry by Santa Barbara Yacht Club ("SBYC") the undersigned acknowledge and agree as follows:

1. The undersigned acknowledge that there are risks inherent in the sport of yacht racing. The undersigned freely assume any and all risks including personal injury or death, and loss or property damage of all types, including unforeseen risks and including, without limitation, the failure or breakage of the vessel described above or of any equipment thereon, arising from inclement weather, adverse sea conditions or otherwise. To the fullest extent allowed by law, the undersigned hereby waive all claims and causes of action, and discharge and release the Santa Barbara Yacht Club, its officers, directors, representatives, agents, employees, members, volunteers and guests, for any and all claims, demands, actions, right of action, of whatsoever kind or nature, either in law or in equity arising from or by reason of any bodily injury or personal injuries know or unknown, death or property damage, resulting from my participation in the regatta, whether by negligence or not.
2. The undersigned certify that the vessel described above is equipped so as to conform to all applicable U.S. Sailing Association and U.S. Coast Guard regulations and safety requirements. The undersigned certify that such vessel is in good, seaworthy and navigable condition and that it complies fully with class equipment rules.
3. The undersigned jointly and severally agree to indemnify, hold harmless and defend the Santa Barbara Yacht Club, its officers, directors, representatives, employees, members, volunteers and guests, from and against any and all claims, causes of action, liability or damages of any nature, arising out of any accident or injury to any person, including, without limitation, myself, or any other vessel, resulting from the actions of the undersigned while racing or while engaging in activities relating to or connected with racing. The undersigned jointly and severally further agree to pay their respective share(s) of any damages, up to the whole thereof, sustained by other persons or vessels as the result of the negligence of the undersigned.
4. The undersigned agree to abide and be bound by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the Prescriptions of the U. S. Sailing Association, the COLREGS/Inland Rules, as applicable, and the Rules of the Santa Barbara Yacht Club, in force from time to time.
5. The undersigned expressly agree that this release and indemnification Agreement provided herein is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of California and that if any portion hereof is held invalid, the balance shall continue in full legal force and effect.

The undersigned parent and/or natural or legal guardian does hereby represent that he/she is, in fact, acting in such capacity and agrees to release each and all of the Released Parties referred to above from all liability, loss, cost, claim or damage whatsoever which may be imposed upon said Party(ies) because of any defect in or lack of such capacity to so act and release said Party(ies) on behalf of all Releasors as specified herein. The undersigned parent or guardian shall serve as the chaperone for the competitor above for the duration of his or her participation in this event including travel to and from the event.
