### **NOTICE OF RACE**

The Organizing Authority for the 2014 Fiesta Cup Regatta will be:  
The Santa Barbara Yacht Club (SBYC), 130 Harbor Way, Santa Barbara, CA 93109

#### **1. RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 The US Sailing prescriptions to rules 60, 63.2, and 63.4 will not apply.

#### **2. ADVERTISING**

- 2.1 Advertising is limited as defined in the class rules of each fleet.

#### **3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1 The regatta is open to members in good standing of an approved one design class and of a US Sailing member club or equivalently recognized sailing organization. **Approved one-design classes include: J/105, J/70, Melges 24, Viper 640, Harbor 20.** Other interested one design classes may contact SBYC for inclusion in the following year's event.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form available at <http://sbycracing.org/2014-fiesta-cup/> and submitting the required entry fee to the Santa Barbara Yacht Club by the entry deadline.
- 3.3 Entries will be considered late after Wednesday, July 2<sup>nd</sup> at 1700 hours. All entries received after this time will be subject to a \$25 late fee and will be accepted at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.
- 3.4 No entries will be accepted after Saturday, July 12<sup>th</sup> at 1000 hours.

#### **4. CLASSIFICATION**

- 4.1 Crew members shall meet class requirements regarding ISAF categories of professionalism.

#### **5. FEES**

- 5.1 Entry Fees are as follows:

**J/105: \$110      J/70: \$75      Melges 24: \$75      Viper: \$60      Harbor 20: \$60**

- 5.2 Entries received after Wednesday July 2<sup>nd</sup> at 1700 hours will be subject to a \$25 late fee.

6.2 For all classes, a total of six (6) races are scheduled with no more than four (4) races to be sailed on any one day.

### **7. MEASUREMENT AND WEIGH-IN**

7.1 Each boat must provide a copy of its current measurement certificate if required by class rules. J/105's shall provide a copy of their current crew declaration form. Previously unweighed crew shall complete weigh-in before 1030 on Saturday July 12, 2014. – DELETED in Amendments

### **8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

8.1 Sailing Instructions will be available online at <http://sbycracing.org/2014-fiesta-cup/> approximately two weeks prior to the event and at registration.

### **9. VENUE**

9.1 The Santa Barbara Harbor, the Santa Barbara Yacht Club, and its end tie dock are as shown in 'Attachment A – Santa Barbara Harbor Map'.

9.2 The racing venue shall be the Santa Barbara Channel within 3 miles of SBYC.

### **10. COURSES**

10.1 A course chart will be attached to the Sailing Instructions. Courses will be a windward-leeward buoy configuration as described therein.

### **11. PENALTY SYSTEM**

11.1 Rule 44.2 will be modified in the Sailing Instructions such that if an incident occurs outside the *zone* for a rounding or finishing mark, a boat that has broken a Rule of Part 2 may take a penalty of one turn including one tack and one gybe.

### **12. SCORING**

12.1 The low-point scoring system of Appendix A will apply.

12.2 One race must be completed to constitute a series.

12.3 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

### **13. PRIZES**

13.1 Take home trophies will be awarded to the top finisher(s) in each class, based on participation.

### **14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

14.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

- 15.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with adequate limits for this event, or the equivalent.

### DOCKING

SBYC has limited free dock space at their end tie from July 7<sup>th</sup> – July 12<sup>th</sup>. This is available on a first come, first serve basis with limited raft up. Boats not going to the SBYC end tie must contact the Santa Barbara Harbor Patrol on VHF channel 16 to request a slip in the harbor. Applicable slip fees are the responsibility of each competitor and may be paid to the harbor department upon arrival. Prices are \$ .90 per foot for each 24 hour period (noon to noon). Advance reservations are not accepted. Boats planning on staying the evening of July 13<sup>th</sup> and into the future must contact the Harbor department for slip options.

**Harbor Patrol Dye Tabs:** All out of town boats that have heads capable of flushing overboard, including those rafting off the SBYC end tie, should contact the Santa Barbara Harbor Patrol upon arrival and tie up to the accommodation dock to receive a head dye tab.

### TRAILER STORAGE & LAUNCHING

Boats launching from trailers may launch from the SBYC hoist located on the west end of the harbor adjacent to SBYC. A key for the SBYC hoist may be obtained from the front desk of SBYC. Trailers may be stored in the back row of the Santa Barbara Harbor Launch Ramp parking area as shown in 'Attachment B – Trailer Storage'. Boats are also welcome to launch from the Santa Barbara Harbor Launch Ramp. Storage fees are the responsibility of competitors.

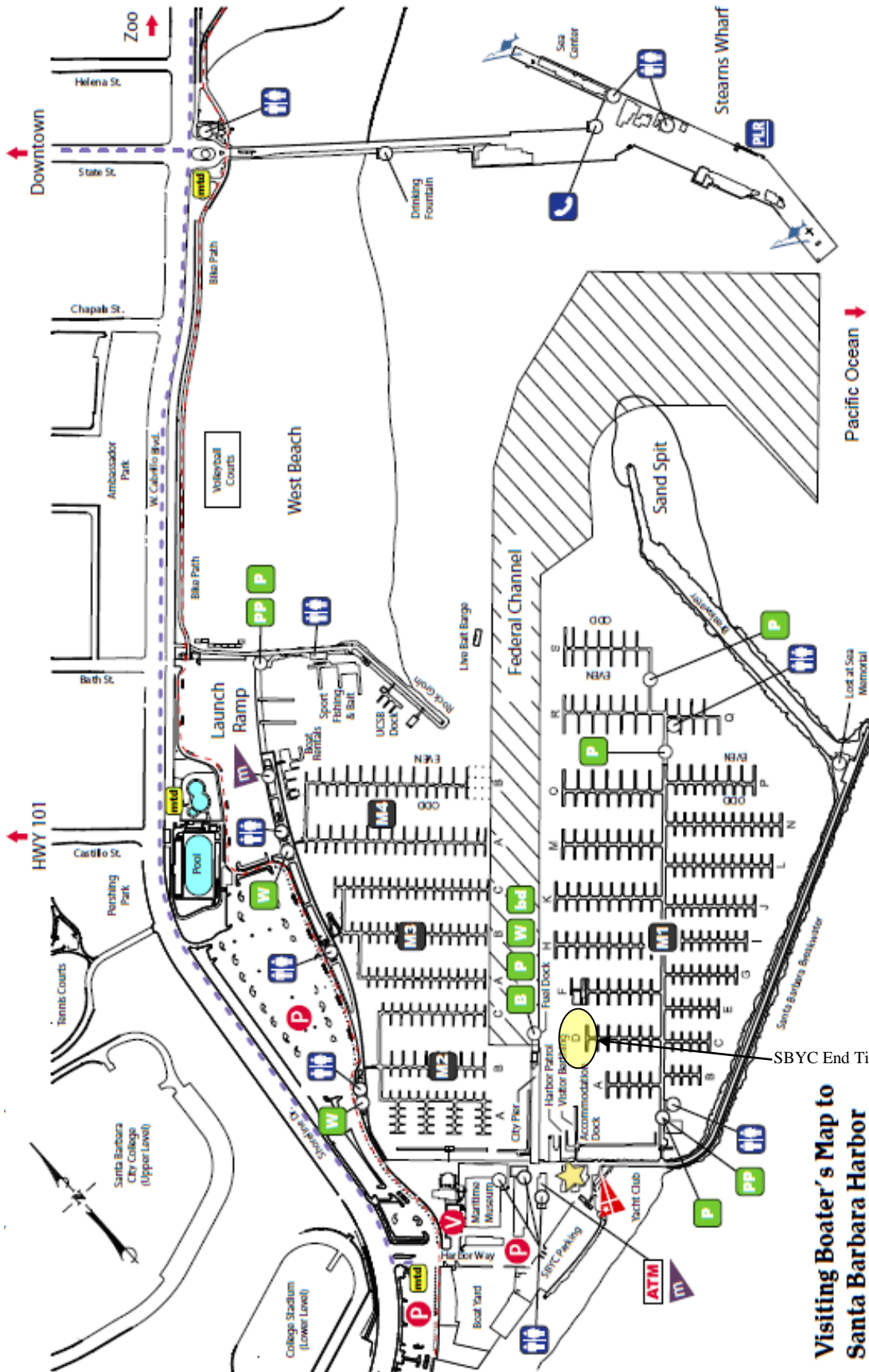

\*Yacht club end tie is on 'D' Dock



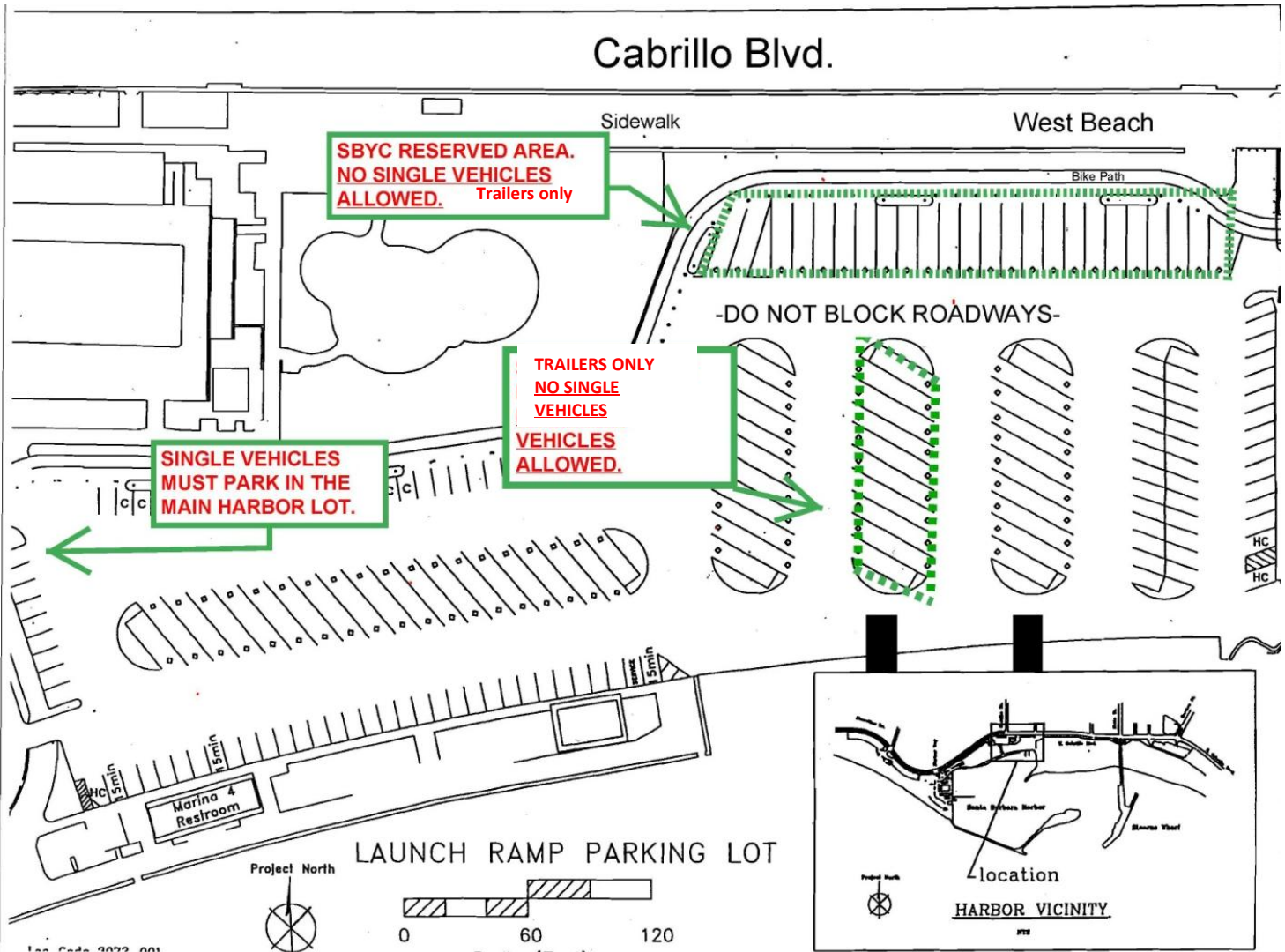

**'Attachment B – Trailer Storage'**



- Do not block roadways while coaching, rigging, loading, or unloading, etc. Rig only in designated areas.
- No single vehicles may be parked in the yellow trailer stalls. Trailers and cars with trailers only.
